Our theme is


WHO IS YOUR GOD?

At Noisy Forest we're all mates. We're kind to each other and work together.




You will have a small group that you spend time with and a couple of leaders whose job it is to look after you and your small group.

If you ever feel unsafe, sad or need something tell your leaders and they will help you - even if it's the middle of the night!


On camp we spend time wrestling with the big questions of life, the universe and everything.
